

Wood fired Hot Tub Key information and Terms & Conditions for use

As the lead guest, you are accepting this acknowledgement and disclaimer on behalf of each member of your party and will ensure each member of your party is aware of and strictly adheres to the guidelines set out below when using the hot tub.

Special Note on Children

Yourself and all members of your party hereby agree to ensure that any children in your care, or associated with your party are supervised at all times when they are in the vicinity of the hot tub. Extreme caution must be taken to ensure that no child under Twelve years of age is permitted to enter the hot tub at any time. Any children over twelve years of age and using the Hot Tub or near the Hot Tub must be closely supervised at all times. The nature of the wood burning Hot Tub mean extra care is needed due to hot surfaces, real fires and chimneys.

Instructions for Use

See information in the hot tub lighting box in the laundry block and lid storage.

- The Hot Tub requires 90 440 minutes
- Use the eco fire lighters and a small amount of kindling to light the stove.
- Once the kindling is burning add a couple of small logs, and then when burning add more logs to build a large fire but don't over fill the stove, you need to air to circulate to allow the logs to burn.
- Once the logs are burning you will need to top up the stove with fresh logs every 30 mins with the vent closed and only if you are using the hot tub. Do not fill up the log burner and leave over night.
 - Once the water is warm, the tub is ready to enjoy.
- Care must be taken when using the stove, no-one under 18 can operate the stove, keep pets away from the stove and young children.
- Use the gauntlets provided when adding wood to the wood burner. Despite a heat
 protection barrier the Log Burner flue will get hot. PLEASE DO NOT TOUCH IT
 All members of your party and yourself as lead guest understand and agree that: Children
 should not go near the hot tub without adult supervision and should never be left
 unattended in or near the hot tub.

The Hot tub is not to be used between 10:00pm and 8am

- . Always enter and exit the hot tub slowly, as the plastic surface of the tub may be slippery.

 . Never jump in the hot tub or subject it to other unintended loads, as this may cause personal injury as well as damage to the hot tub.
- · A wood fired hot tub needs extra caution due to the natural, unregulated way the water is



heated. It is essential to test the water temperature before entering. Recommended temperature 37.5 degrees.

. Do not overheat the hot tub, keep the water temperature no higher than 41°C. Higher water temperatures can cause strain on the cardiovascular system.

If the hot tub heat goes over 47 degrees on the thermometer The Bringewood has the right to close the hot tubs for the duration of your stay due to misuse and if any damaged caused to the tubs due to overheating the lead guest will be charged

Limit the hot tub use to no more than 15-20 minutes at a time and if when you feel you are getting too hot, get out and allow your body to cool, when you feel comfortable you may submerse yourself back in

- · The use of drugs, alcohol and some medications before or during use of the hot tub may lead to unconsciousness with the possibility of drowning and can greatly increase the risk of fatal hyperthermia.
 - · Glass items are strictly prohibited from use in the hot tub.
- No member of your party may use the hot tub without prior consultation with a doctor if he/she is obese or has a medical history of heart disease, low or high blood pressure, circulatory system problems or diabetes.
 - · Some medications may induce drowsiness and others may affect heart rate, blood pressure and circulation. If any member of your party has recently taken or is currently taking any medication, he/she will consult a doctor before using the hot tub.
- · No member of your party may use the hot tub if he/she has an infectious disease or has any open sores and/or wounds due to the possibility of spreading infection.
- · No member of your party may use the hot tub if she is pregnant or potentially pregnant without prior consultation with a doctor.
 - · Prolonged immersion in the hot tub may be hazardous to health.
 - · The hot tub must not be used immediately after strenuous exercise.
- · All members of your party will shower both before and after using the hot tub. We ask guests not to add any oils or lotions to the water and request they shower before use to remove any fake tan, deodorants etc.
- The Bringewood reserve the right to charge a cleaning fee of £50 (per hot tub) should the hot tub require deep cleaning during your stay due to non-showering, drink, food and other debris.
- · Under no circumstances should the cover of the hot tub be removed by yourself or any member of your party when it is not in use. When not in use please cover using the lid provided to retain heat and also stop debris (leaves etc.) from blowing onto the tub. Use safety straps on the lid when the hot tub is not in use



DONT stand on the lid on or off the hot tub as this will damage the lid

· Under no circumstances should any member of your party release water from the hot tub during your stay. The hot tub may not be available during extreme or adverse weather conditions, no discount is available

No pets are allowed in the hot tubs

Only Bringewood guests are allowed to use the hot tub, external guests are not allowed. The hot tub is only available to guests at The Bringewood.

During such events as weddings, christenings, etc the Hot tub will not be available for use.
